


ENERGY EFFICIENCY CLASSES

Good to know!

The **new** energy efficiency classes are now calculated according to the **luminous efficacy** of the lamps. This describes how much **luminous flux** (lumens) can be obtained from **power** (watts).

Due to this new assessment method, it is not possible to translate the old efficiency classes to the new ones. Each light source must therefore be recalculated.



The entire product range of ISOLED® follows the EU directives for LED lamps. (EPREL)

The EU Regulation 2017/1369 provides, among other things, for mandatory labelling of all light sources. The new energy label divides light sources into 7 classes: from A for "very efficient" to G "less efficient".
